Scholarship Guidelines

Background:

Prince Hall Education Foundation (PHEF) is a non-profit organization created to support and perform Charitable, Educational and Mentoring programs.

Eligibility and General Information:

1. Applicants must be a minority.
2. Applicants must be a graduating senior or an undergraduate in an accredited college or university.
3. The scholarship is a cash award payable to the recipient or to a college/university of the recipient's designation. The amount and number of awards will vary depending upon the monies available.
4. High School GPA (grade point average) of 2.5 or college GPA of 3.0 is required.
5. Applicants must be enrolled in a college/university before the scholarship money is released.
6. Primary consideration for the scholarship is scholastic achievement, leadership qualities and community involvement.

APPLICATION DEADLINE: March 31st, annually

When March 31st falls on a Saturday or Sunday, the Monday following the March 31st due date will be the application deadline. The application must reach the scholarship committee on or before this date. This is not a postmark deadline.

APPLICATION PROCEDURES:

In order to be considered for the Prince Hall Education Foundation of Nebraska Scholarship, an applicant must comply with the listed application procedures.

1. The applicant must complete the scholarship application form.
2. The applicant must write a one-page essay explaining why he/she wishes to be considered for the Prince Hall Education Foundation Scholarship.
3. The applicant must submit a high school or college transcript, and two (2) letters of recommendation from a counselor, teacher, or other school official or community leader. It is the responsibility of the student to secure the letters of recommendations to be returned with the application.
4. The applicant must send the scholarship application, official high school transcript or college transcript, two (2) letters of recommendation, and the one page essay to:
